Key Work Areas & Progress

- **Manufacturing Ecosystem** – Sector-wide assessments across diagnostics, critical care equipment, and hospital furniture to support import substitution.
- **Consumables Strategy** – Capacity reviews for PPE, disposables, and infection control products, positioning them as strategic export pillars.
- **Global Compliance** – Advocacy for ISO, WHO, and CE alignment, strengthening traceability and a culture of quality.
- **Market Positioning** – Advancing the narrative of Bangladesh as an emerging MedTech hub through regional stakeholder engagement.
- **Institutional Strength** – Streamlined internal data and advocacy workflows to improve coordination between members and leadership.

January reduced fragmentation and raised the compliance bar across the ecosystem. MEDMEB has evolved beyond a traditional association — we are now a catalyst for safe, affordable, and globally competitive healthcare solutions.
